

Cosán Workshops Supporting reflective cultures in schools

Schools are invited to nominate three staff members (including one senior leader) to engage in a professional learning programme on *Cosán*, the national framework for teachers' learning. The programme will support teachers in reflecting on their learning so as to maximise its impact

The programme encompasses three workshops facilitated by practising teachers. The workshops will take place in the Education Centres listed below in 2020 and it is anticipated that it will be rolled out nationally over time.
