OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH STRATEGY FOR REGISTERED TEACHERS AND SPECIAL NEEDS ASSISTANTS

In Recognised Primary and Post Primary Schools

As a result of the 2013 Budget provisions for Education, arising from current economic challenges, the Minister for Education and Skills wishes to inform management authorities of the revised arrangements in relation to the referral of teachers and special needs assistants to the Occupational Health Service.

The new arrangements will be introduced on a phased basis as follows:

- From 1 February 2013, any teacher who has 4 weeks continuous or 12 weeks cumulative sick leave in a 12 month rolling period and any special needs assistant who has 4 weeks continuous or 8 weeks cumulative sick leave in a 12 month rolling period must be referred to the Occupational Health Service.
- From 1 January 2014, any teacher/special needs assistant on sick leave who has 4 weeks continuous or cumulative sick leave absence in a 12 month rolling period must be referred to the Occupational Health Service.

A revised Occupational Health Service Standard Operating Procedures Manual to assist employers in accessing the service is attached to this circular.

The regulations and procedures are to be implemented as above and will supersede all previous circulars, memoranda, rules and regulations in relation to assessment of medical fitness prior to or during the course of employment.
